Parish Mission Giving Update:

The retiring collection at the 6.30pm Carol Service at Hordle amounted to £347.06 which has been given to the Lymington Food Bank.

The result of the Mission Giving Gift Sundays in Hordle and Tiptoe during November, including Gift Aid, was £3,201 which will be split between Tear Fund, Bible Society, and Leprosy Mission and remitted to them .

This will be in addition to the monies raised earlier in the year on the individual Mission Sundays .

Finally the Auction of Promises in November raised £2,000, which will benefit Oakhaven Hospice and church funds.
