CHURCH CALENDAR for May to September are available at the back of the church. Also, the May edition of LINK magazine. Do pick up both so that you know what is going on in our parish.

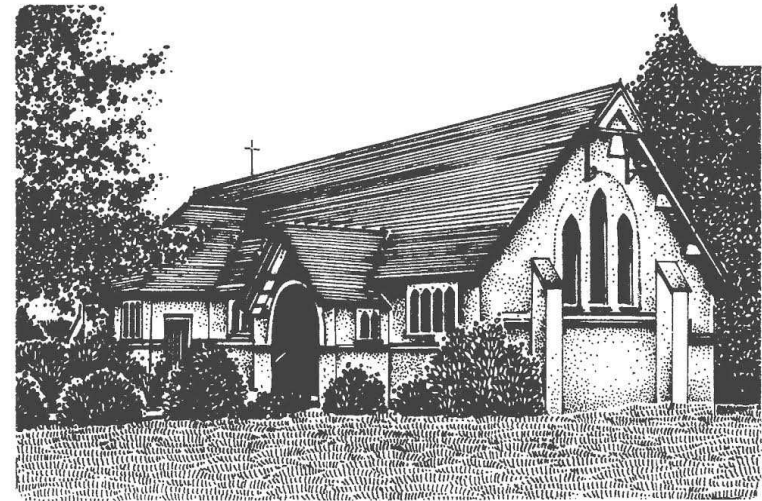
