POTTING SHED is next Friday 13th of July, at Redcliffe Garden Centre. If you need a lift, please call Julie on 627325.

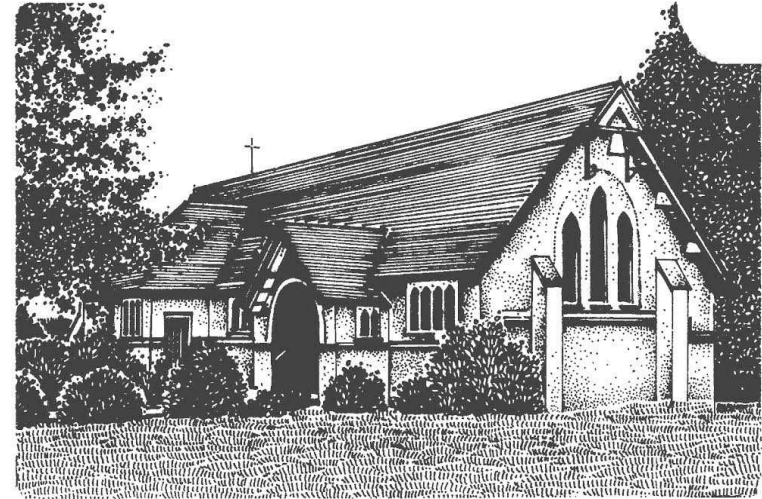
